WARNINGS AND PRECAUTIONS



This appliance must be installed, commissioned and serviced by a qualified person in accordance with national and local regulations in force in the country of installation.

If the supply cord is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer, its service agent or similarly qualified person.

Ensure that the plug/socket is accessible at all times.

Strip plastic coating and clean the appliance before use.

During operation parts may become hot - avoid accidental contact.

Disconnect this appliance before servicing, maintenance or cleaning.

INSTALLATION AND COMMISSIONING

This appliance must be earthed.

If replacing the plug connect the terminals as follows:

Green and Yellow wire Earth E
Blue wire Neutral N
Brown wire Live L

Supply cords shall be oil resistant, sheathed flexible cable not lighter than ordinary polychloroprene or equivalent elastomer sheathed cord (code 60245 IEC 57)

Push rubber feet into base holes provided. Install this appliance on a level surface ensuring all vents are unobstructed. Any partitions, walls or furniture must be of non-combustible material. Minimum distances A 100mm B 1000mm – see Fig 1.



Instructions for fixing to wall brackets are provided with the brackets.

Dirty extraction filters and drip trays may become a fire hazard due to a build-up of grease/fat and also drip down onto equipment below. Regular cleaning of

extraction filters and drip trays <u>MUST</u> be carried out and it's the installer's responsibility to make the operator aware of this.

If the unit is installed above or adjacent to a heat source, the maximum temperature surrounding the unit must be no greater than 50°C. The installer will need to use an insulated shelf and install heat shields to protect the unit as required.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Only qualified or trained personnel should use this appliance.

Connect the appliance to an electrical supply – the green neon illuminates to indicate power to the appliance.

Turn the control knob to the desired setting.

CLEANING



Do not use a water jet or steam cleaner, and do not immerse this appliance.

Clean all panels with warm water and mild detergent, do not use abrasive materials. Dry with a soft cloth.
